Qualifying Schedule:

Texas Wizards Tourney: Fri. 9am - 12am, and Sat. 9am - 4pm

Classics Side Tourney: Fri. 9am - 12am

Kids Tourney & Parent/Child Tourney: Fri. 12pm – 10pm, and Sat. 9am-2pm

Finals Schedule:

Classics Side Tourney: Sat. 9am (check-in at 8:45am) Sat. 2:30pm (check-in at 2:15pm) Kids Tourney: Parent/Child Tourney: Sat. 3:30pm (check-in at 3:15pm) Texas Wizards Tourney (A, B, Novice): Sat. 5pm (check-in at 4:30pm) Texas Wizards Tourney (Women's): Sat. 6pm (check-in at 4:30pm)

Texas Wizards Tournament: This is the MAIN EVENT! (For other Tourneys, see reverse side)

- Maximum of 160 players, it sells out FAST! http://texaspinball.com/tpf/tpfstore/
- \$70 one-time entry fee. Entry fees paid back to players in the form of cash and prizes, after expenses.
- Open qualifying for four different division finals with prizes and trophies for each division.
 - Division Finalists: 24 "A" Division, 8 B Div., 8 Novice Div., and 8 Women's Div.
 - No need to select your division you are automatically entered into your eligible division.
- Limited entry best-game qualifying format, across three Eras of pins:
 - Limit of 20 plays per player, using your best ranking results from 8 pins.
 - Best 8 pins must include at least two pins from each Era of pins.
- 12 pins to play from 3 Eras: 4 Modern, 4 SS (Solid State), 4 EM (Electro-Mechanical).
- PAPA-style group finals: 3 games per round, one pin from each Era, 4-2-1-0 scoring, top 2 players advance.
- Additional \$50 prize given to top qualifier in each Era (sum of all four pins in each Era).
- Division Restrictions: A Division: Open to all; B & Novice Division: 500+ & 3,000+ IFPA World Rankings, respectively.

If 160 players, approximate estimated cash prizes:

A Division

1st place = \$2,000
2nd place = \$1,400
3rd place = \$900
4th place = \$700
5th through 8th place = \$190 each
9th through 16th place = \$100 each

Classics Side Tournament **OPEN TO ALL TPF SHOW ATTENDEES**

Unlimited open qualifying (unlimited best-game entry, "Herb" style); your best ranking on 4 of the 6 pins count. Entry: 2 plays for \$5, or 5 plays for \$10, or 12 plays for \$20, distributed across pins of your choosing. Buy as many entries as you like. Entry fees are paid back to players in the form of cash and prizes, after expenses. Finals: 16 players qualify for PAPA-style group finals: 3 games per round, 4-2-1-0 scoring, top 2 players advance, group high seeds pick one sequential bank of three pins.

Kid's "Bump 'N Win" Tournament

Open to kids 12 and under. Entry is \$5 for 2 plays on one designated tournament pin. Maximum of 2 entries per kid (4 plays total) allowed. 4-Ball game.

Top 4 highest scores advance to one-game playoff held at 2:30pm on Saturday. Highest seed may choose his/her order of playing position in the playoff.

Prizes:

1st place = \$100 GameStop Gift Card + Trophy 2nd place = \$50 GameStop Gift Card + Trophy 3rd place = \$25 GameStop Gift Card + Trophy 4th place = Trophy

Parent/Child Tournament

Child must be 12 or under. Entry is \$10 per team for 2 plays. Maximum of 2 entries (4 plays total) allowed per team. 4-Ball game: Child plays balls 1 & 3. The Parent/Child team plays "split flipper" on balls 2 & 4. "Split flipper" = both players play simultaneously, with each player controlling only one flipper button. Players are allowed to switch which button they control between each ball, if desired. Top 4 highest team scores advance to one-game playoff held at 3:30pm on Saturday. Highest seeded team may choose their order of playing position in the playoff.

Prizes: 1st - 4th place = Trophy

Note: Each parent or child can only play on one Parent/Child team. If you have two children, 2 different parents need to participate in this event for both kids to play, etc. "Parent" may be a parent, grandparent, or quardian.
